



2018-2019 Official Policies & Tuition Plan

ATTENDANCE

Regular attendance is expected. It is necessary to learn proper technique, develop self-confidence, and for the entire class to progress.

All students will be included in the end-of-year performance, for which costumes, rehearsals and attendance are also required.

You must notify us of any student dropping classes by the 10th of the month, or you will be billed for the entire month. Students have the option of dropping out of the program only until January 1, 2019.

TRIAL CLASSES

Students may sample up to two classes without fully registering at a flat \$20 per session fee.

If student then enrolls, payment will be credited toward full tuition if there are any remaining classes that month.

STUDENT BEHAVIOR & DRESS CODE

Please be ready on time for class—arrive a few minutes early to get yourself prepared.

Do not bring anything valuable to the studio—we are not responsible for your property.

No food or drink in the studio.

No gum is allowed in any class.

Please do not allow your children to have candy or soda before coming to class.

Wait until the previous class is dismissed to enter the studio.

Our studio is a positive, judgement-free zone where we do not tolerate disrespect (of staff or other students) or bullying. Any student who does not comply will be expelled from the program.

Hair should be worn up and away from the face. No loose hair.

No loose jewelry.

Please adhere to our dress code. **NO TANK TOPS OR SHORTS MAY BE WORN.**

Ballet – Class color leotard* (list below), pink tights, ballet skirt, PINK ballet shoes. **HAIR MUST BE IN A TIGHT BUN.**

*Leotards and ballet skirts are sold at the studio. Leotards must be exact color and style. Similar leotards purchased elsewhere are not acceptable.

Jazz – BLACK jazz shoes, dance clothing (pants preferred), no skirts longer than mid-calf.

Tap – BLACK Tap shoes, no skirts longer than mid-calf.

Hip Hop – Loose, comfortable clothing (pants preferred), no skirts longer than mid-calf, sneakers (worn only at the studio)

We do have a dance shoe gemach at the studio. Shoes may be taken free of charge. Please donate outgrown shoes to keep the gemach going.

FOR PARENTS

Please be on time to pick up your children. In case of inclement weather, call 1 hour prior to class or check our website for updates.

MISSED CLASSES

Students are encouraged to make up missed classes. Make-ups may be taken in a class of a lower level (if available) or in a class of a different style. Make-ups must be taken by the end of the month following the missed class. **Missed classes around the time of yom tov will NOT be credited!**

Pre-Ballet: (1 hour class @ \$18/class)
\$72 per month, annual pay in advance price: \$576

Ballet I, II: (1.25 hour class @ \$22/class)
\$88 per month, annual pay in advance price: \$704

Tap I, Jazz I: (1 hour class @ \$21/class)
\$84 per month, annual pay in advance price: \$672

Ballet IV, V, Tap III, Jazz III: (1.5 hour class @ \$23/class)
\$92 per month, annual pay in advance price: \$736

Pre-Pointe: \$45 per month, \$405 flat fee for the year
Pointe: \$50 per month, \$450 flat fee for the year

Ballet VI: (1.5 hour class twice a week and 1 hour pointe class)
\$175 per month, annual pay in advance price: \$1,400

Acting I, II, III (**1st Semester Only—Oct-Dec**): (1.25 hour class @ \$22/class)
\$73 per month, entire 1st semester price: \$220
2nd Semester fees and schedule will be determined in December. Costume fee will only be charged to those selected for the end-of-the-year show.

Jazz II, Tap II: (1 hour class @ \$21/class)
\$79 per month, annual pay in advance price: \$635

Contemporary I, Ballet III: (1.25 hour class @ \$22/class)
\$83 per month, annual pay in advance price: \$665

Contemporary II, Hip Hop: (1.5 hour class @ \$23/class)
\$87 per month, annual pay in advance price: \$695

Yearly discounted price is only IF PAID UPFRONT IN FULL. Prices are based on the number of classes per year and are divided up over nine months (Oct-June). Discounts available for multiple classes by same student or multiple students in same family. Monthly payers are requested to present post-dated checks at registration or set up recurring credit card payments. Tuition must be paid at least one month in advance if paying by check or cash.

III: Performance Fees

Costume Fee: \$60
Please note costumes are studio property and cannot be kept by students.
Refundable only through January 1, 2019

Performance Fee (includes 1 parent ticket) \$50 (does not apply to Creative Movement or Pre-ballet students)
Non-refundable, due by Jan 15, 2019

Performance Fee for Acting Presentation \$35

PAYMENT POLICIES

Tuition for the coming month is due on the 1st of the month and is the same every month, regardless of the number of classes per month or if a student misses a class.

A \$10.00 late fee is charged for tuition not received by the 10th of the month.

There is a \$25.00 returned check fee.
